House Rules

To ensure everyone has a pleasant experience, we kindly ask you to observe the following house rules:

1. Check-In Time: from 2:00 PM.

Check-Out Time: By 11:00 AM (if you need to check out earlier and nobody will be in the office – leave us a message and put the keys on the table in your apartment then just close the door).

Late check-outs may be available upon request, availability and additional fees.

2. Reception Hours

Please note that the reception is open from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

If you require assistance outside these hours, please contact us on Booking.com or phone number.

3. Quiet Hours

Please observe quiet hours from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM, to respect other guests and neighbors.

4. Smoking Policy

Smoking is strictly **prohibited inside the apartment**. You can smoke in the hallway, where the ashtrays are.

5. Pets

Pets are allowed upon prior request. Additional fee of 15 EUR per 1 pet.

6. Cleanliness

Please keep the apartment clean and tidy during your stay – we don't offer daily cleaning (fresh towels/toilet paper on request)

Notify staff promptly of any damages or issues to avoid additional charges.

7. Wifi

Each apartment has their own wifi - password under TV.

8. Laundry service

Laundry service costs 15 EUR in cash (if you need to use laundry service, leave us a message)

9. Parking

Private garage (1 car only – limited capacity). Further reservation needed. The cost is 30/EUR per night.

Location Highlights

1.Proximity to Key Attractions

- a) Wenceslas Square (Václavské náměstí): 300 meters away, a cultural and historical hub, filled with shops, restaurants, and bars.
- b) **National Museum** (Národní muzeum): 200 meters away, featuring Czech history, natural history exhibits, and a stunning Neo-Renaissance design.
- c) **Old Town Square** (Staroměstské náměstí): A 15-minute walk or a short tram ride, the Astronomical Clock, the Church of Our Lady before Týn, and lively cafes.
- d) **Charles Bridge** (Karlův most): 20-minute walk, offering stunning views of the Vltava River and **Prague Castle**.

2. Nightlife

Surrounded by a variety of restaurants serving Czech and international cuisine. Bars, clubs, and cafes are within walking distance

Popular Night clubs nearby:

- <u>Duplex</u> (300 metres 5 min walk)
- <u>Retro Music Hall</u> (Ox club) (1,5km 20 min walk)
- <u>Karlovy Lázně</u> (17 min walk)
- <u>Dlouhá street</u> (11 min walk): street full of famous Prague clubs (James Dean, Moonclub, Roxy, 80s etc.)

3. Transportation Access

Metro Stations:

- Muzeum Station (Lines A and C): 7-minute walk (400 meters).
- Můstek Station (Lines A and B): 8-minute walk (470 meters).

Tram Stops: Wenceslas Square and Štěpánská

Airport Access: well-connected to Václav Havel Airport Prague (PRG) via metro and bus links <u>AE</u> <u>Express</u> from railway station (Hlavní nádraží).

We offer transfer service to the airport.

The transfer costs 800 CZK (approx 30 EUR) for sedan car/1000 CZK (40 EUR) for minivan per one trip. You can pay with card / cash directly to the driver. If you're interested leave us message.

5. Shopping and Essentials

Close to shopping centers Palladium and Slovanský dům.

Boutiques and souvenir shops along Wenceslas Square.

Convenience Stores: Grocery shops and pharmacies are within walking distance for daily essentials.

6. Green Spaces

Franciscan Garden (Františkánská zahrada): A peaceful retreat near Wenceslas Square Riegrovy Sady Park: A bit further but great for panoramic city views and outdoor activities. Kampa park

Cuisine: traditional Czech Address: Dlouhá 33, 110 00 Praha 1 Classic Czech dishes like <u>svíčková</u> (beef with creamy sauce) and <u>goulash</u>, as well as fresh, local <u>pilsner</u> beer. It's a great spot for an authentic Czech dining experience. Recommended dish: svíčková, guláš, Pilsner beer

2. Kolkovna

Cuisine: czech Address: Kolkovna 8, 110 00 Praha 1 Traditional Czech food in a rustic, cozy atmosphere. Variety of Czech beers. Recommended dish: pork knee, czech dumplings

3. U Fleků

Cuisine: traditional czech U Fleků is a historic pub and microbrewery. Established in 1499 - one of the oldest breweries in Prague. Address: Křemencova 11, 110 00 Praha 1 Reccommended dish: goulash, svíčková, tatarák, fried cheese, pork knee

6. Sushi bar Made in Japan


